ATCO ENHANCES FIRE TRAINING CAPACITY IN SLAVE LAKE

Donation of two water tanks to aid live fire training exercises

SLAVE LAKE, Alberta – ATCO today announced the donation of two 8,700 gallon water tanks to the Lesser Slave Regional Fire Service. The tanks will be used by the Fire Service to enhance its live fire training exercises.

The water tanks previously provided water for the temporary housing facility ATCO used to accommodate its employees sent to restore electricity and natural gas service to the area following the northern wildfires earlier this summer. With the bulk of ATCO's restoration and clean-up efforts in the community and surrounding area addressed, the temporary facility is no longer required and is being de-mobilized. Any additional ATCO employees who remain will utilize existing local accommodation.

"This gift will be a legacy to enhance the capacity of future fire training in the area," said Bobbi Lambright, President, Operations Division, ATCO Electric. "We have strong roots in Slave Lake and many of our employees call it home. We are committed to helping the Town in its re-building efforts."
