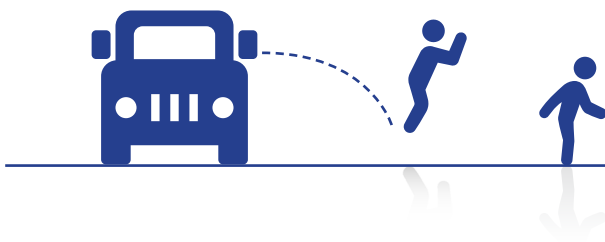




Always assume a power line is energized. If you hit a power line or power pole with your vehicle, stay safe with these tips:

IF YOU CONTACT A POWER POLE

- 1 Break the contact.** Drive at least 10 metres away, if possible. If you can't, stay put. Tell others to back away at least 10 metres and call 911.
- 2 If you can't drive, stay put.** Keep all passengers in your vehicle and call 911. Leave only when ATCO or the emergency responders says it is safe to leave.
- 3 IT'S BEST TO STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE,** but if you must exit your vehicle, follow these steps to stay safe.
 - > Call for help.** Call 911 or ATCO's electricity emergency line (1-800-668-5506).
 - > Open the door** to your vehicle as wide as possible.
 - > Jump from your vehicle,** landing with both feet together. **When jumping, make sure you don't touch the vehicle and ground at the same time.** If you jump with your feet apart, it could cause an electrical circuit to run through your body.
 - > Shuffle or hop, don't step.** After you jump, shuffle or hop at least 10 metres away. **Ensure the heel of one foot never passes the toe of the other. Don't touch anything (vehicle, passengers) until you're clear.**
