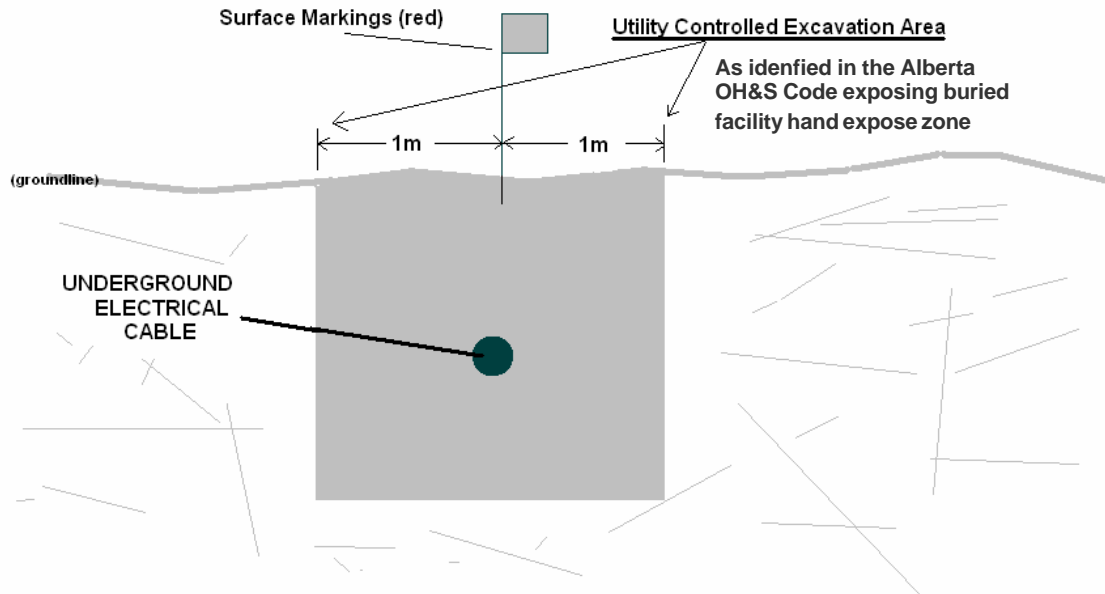


MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR UNQUALIFIED WORKERS AND/OR EQUIPMENT OPERATING NEAR UNDERGROUND CABLES



Purpose: These minimum requirements are for your protection and safety. Contact with underground power cables is extremely dangerous and could result in death.

- 1) Prior to any ground disturbance, the person responsible for the excavation must **contact ALBERTA ONE CALL** to ascertain whether underground power cables are located at or near the excavation site.
 - a) For ATCO facilities, call **ALBERTA ONE CALL at 1-800-242-3447** to request a locate.
 - b) For other underground facilities, contact the operator of the facility.
- 2) Prior to any ground disturbance or excavation activity, ATCO Electric will identify and mark any underground cables that are located near the utility controlled excavation area.
- 3) The person responsible for an excavation must make sure that no excavation work is undertaken within **1 m** of any underground power cables unless:
 - a) The excavation work is done under the control of ATCO Electric, **and**
 - b) The excavation work method is approved by ATCO Electric.
