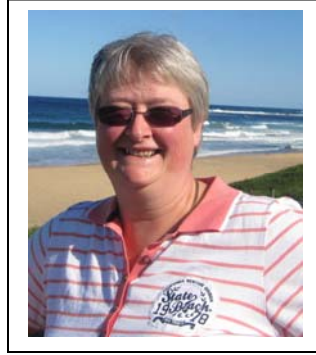


Donna Coombs
